

***Conference Host- Ken Nash President and CEO Nuclear Waste Management Organization***

Ken Nash was appointed President of the Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO) in 2006. He is a founding director of the NWMO and a past chair of the organization's Board of Directors. He was responsible for overseeing the NWMO study of approaches for the long-term management of used nuclear fuel and making recommendations to the Government of Canada. He is now responsible for implementing the plan approved by the Government of Canada. He is also past Chair of EDRAM, an association of nuclear waste management organizations from 11 countries, including Canada.

He has held a number of senior management positions at Ontario Hydro and Ontario Power Generation, including finance, engineering, environmental management, policy development, and waste management. Prior to joining Ontario Hydro, he worked for British Nuclear Fuels on a range of existing and advanced reactor fuel designs and as a senior design engineer in the reprocessing/recycling division.
