Kathryn Shaver leads NWMO's APM site selection process for the deep geological repository for Canada's used nuclear fuel. She also oversees NWMO's public engagement and communications.

Ms. Shaver is responsible for managing the site selection project to identify a safe location for the used fuel repository, with an informed, willing host. Ms. Shaver leads a multi-disciplinary team that conducts technical and social assessments of potential suitability of sites for the repository, and works closely with communities in collaboratively exploring the APM project.

Ms. Shaver joined the NWMO upon its establishment in 2002 as Executive Director. She supported the three-year national dialogue and study of alternative management approaches for Canada's used nuclear fuel. She was involved in the development of the APM program, NWMO's recommendation subsequently presented to Government in 2005.

Prior to joining the NWMO, Ms. Shaver worked at OPG in sustainable development. Prior to that, she worked with the Government of Ontario for thirteen years on a variety of environment, energy and finance portfolios.
