



Danine Chief is a member of the Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation. She has been the Nuclear Waste Information Liaison in the community. Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation is located 75 km west of Ignace. Danine organizes information sessions on Nuclear Waste in the small community of 200 people (on reserve) with a total population of 750 members. Her background includes working in finance for 9 years, a diploma in Police Foundations and is currently in her final year pursuing a degree in Indigenous Social Work at Laurentian University. Danine has a strong belief in maintaining the Ojibway culture through ceremony and language revitalization. She is also a proud “kokum” of 4 beautiful grandchildren and spends her personal time with family and enjoying the outdoors in Northwestern Ontario.
